Dear Friends,

Thanks to the passion and dedication of our volunteers, artists, and donors, 2023 was a record-breaking year of impact for Brushwood Center at Ryerson Woods. **Brushwood Center's initiatives connected more than 10,000 people to art and nature in Lake County and across the Chicago region.**

This year, Brushwood Center released our new report, *Health, Equity, and Nature: A Changing Climate in Lake County, Illinois.* We shared the report's findings and recommendations with more than 3,000 civic leaders and community members to date, sparking change in sectors across our community from city governments to small businesses.

Through our *It's A W.I.N. (Art and Wellness in Nature)* initiative, students and families engaged in field trips, art classes, concerts, and education programs across Lake County. *Nature Explorer Backpacks / Mochilas de Explorador* had an unparalleled year, providing backpacks with art and educational resources to more than 1,200 youth.

Our *At Ease* initiative served more than 600 Veterans this year. Utilizing the healing power of arts and nature, this program is improving the health, wellbeing, and quality of life for military and Veteran populations, as well as their families and caregivers.

Brushwood Center collaborated with more than 90 partners and 300 artists to improve health, equity, and access to nature, all while centering community voices and strengths. Our year culminated with Baratunde Thurston, Distinguished Environmental Leadership Awardee, gracing the stage at the 40th Annual Smith Nature Symposium, and celebrating Brushwood's *Connecting to Our Common Ground* exhibition in partnership with Hyde Park Art Center and Patric McCoy.

Thank you for sharing your commitment with us, for believing in Brushwood Center's vision, and ensuring a year of impact in 2023!

Our Mission



The report was distributed through community partnerships and outreach, including a presentation at the National Land Trust Alliance's Rally for Land conference as well as Brushwood Center's Third Annual Community Leadership Roundtable. Brushwood also co-hosted the On the Grounds program series with Drip & Culture, a community-focused coffee shop in Waukegan. This series combined nature walks, coffee demonstrations, and discussions on health equity with community members.





At Ease Art and Nature for Veterans and the Military Community

More than doubling our impact over the last two years, the full force of At Ease was expanded through new community engagement tools. At Ease blossomed this year with weekly art programming and nature walks for Veterans and the Military Community, a new six-week musical composition residency, a Women Veterans retreat, and more. At Ease mentored five Skillbridge interns in 2023 through a partnership with the United States Department of Defense.



It's AW.I.N. Art and Wellness in Nature

It's A W.I.N. co-created culturally sensitive programs, classes, field trips, and nature outings for more than 2,000 youth and families. This included publishing "Find Yourself Outside," a kid-friendly interpretation of the Health, Equity, and Nature Report. We distributed this activity book at Brushwood events and through community partners. The activity book was also included as part of our Nature Explorer Backpacks / Mochilas de Explorador. This was the largest year of impact yet for the Nature *Explorer Backpacks*. Thanks to unprecedented donations, Brushwood Center reached more families than ever before. 77% of surveyed families felt more confident exploring the outdoors as a result of the Nature Explorer Backpacks.


BASE Brushwood Art Supply Exchange
