

AT EASE

ART AND NATURE FOR VETERANS AND THE MILITARY COMMUNITY

At Ease is an innovative approach to empower the wellbeing of Veterans and the Military Community. It is the only Veterans program in the region offering a nature-based approach that helps build skills in creative expression, while also providing access to mental health support. 900+ participants gather annually to get outside, and explore and express their emotions through nature-based art, music, and photography workshops.


Veterans face disproportionately higher rates of substance abuse, depression, and challenges reintegrating into society. A recent survey by Wounded Warriors found that 54% of Veterans indicated that their mental health had worsened during the pandemic.

Guided by our At Ease Veterans Advisory Committee, *At Ease* is a partnership with local Veteran organizations, the Lovell Federal Health Care Center, natural area sites, and teaching artists and musicians.

The At Ease Veterans Advisory Committee helps ensure that the program engages with Veterans' lived experiences.

At Ease serves Military Veterans, current Service Members, including Active duty, Reserve and National Guard, and all family members.

90% of the Military Veterans who participate in *At Ease* each year, express a resulting increased sense of wellbeing in program evaluations.



ART EXHIBITION NOVEMBER 9 - 30

This year's exhibition, At Ease In Nature highlights the diversity that can be found in nature, but also exists in the armed forces, making each stronger than they would be without it. In keeping with this theme, we welcomed any media of art, any style, and any level of artistic expression that uses nature somewhere in its inspiration or creation.

In 2015, Brushwood Center began its At Ease initiative, offering programs for Veterans, Service Members and their families designed to empower their wellbeing through nature-based art, music, and photography workshops. Through this exhibition, we feature work created during our At Ease programs, as well as work inspired by experiences in nature from other members of this community.

AT EASE **PROGRAMS AND PARTNERSHIPS**

ART IMPACT PROJECT

Art Impact Project facilitates supportive art projects designed to provide participants a different way to express themselves through art-making. With a focus on emotional wellness through creative expression, Art Impact Project's small-group environment gives participants the chance to self-reflect and safely share their observations. Each 90-minute session involves the completion of an art project from start to finish. Projects will vary from week to week, exploring various art media and objectives.

ACRYLIC PAINT & SIP NIGHTS FOR VETERANS AND MILITARY COMMUNITY MEMBERS

This educational and therapeutic acrylic painting event, led by Veteran artists invites Veterans of all skill levels. Classes take place at the American Legion Cicero Post 96 where refreshments are available to purchase.

WATERCOLOR FOR THE SOUL | Music of Lake Michigan

In this six-week residency, Black Moon Trio guided Veterans from the Captain James A. Lovell Federal Health Care Center and We Serve: Special Recreation Association for Central Lake County to create their very own musical compositions.

Using resources from Brushwood Center's At Ease and Art Supply Exchange programs, Veterans participated in a six-week graphic score and poetry composition residency culminating in the creation of 20 original pieces of music performed and recorded by professional musicians.

Heeyoung Kim and members of her Botanical Art Academy showcased watercolor painting methods and techniques, and poet-in-residence and creativity expert Kathryn Haydon joined the team. Her collection of



poetry, *Unsalted Blue Sunrise*: *Poems of Lake Michigan* provided a thematic framework for Veterans to compose works about their connections to our freshwater treasure.

This program has been generously funded by the National Endowment for the Arts' Creative Forces initiative.

WATERCOLOR PAINTING FOR WOMEN VETERANS AND WOMEN FAMILY MEMBERS

This virtual 90-minute class develops unique artistic expression through watercolor painting. Participants will delight in the colorful, transformative nature of the watercolor while also sharing factual information about the natural world and flowers.

PAINT AND PHOTOGRAPH THE PRAIRIE

Veterans, current service members, and their families joined *At Ease* and Veteran Art Tribe at the Midewin Tallgrass Prairie for painting and photography.


